- The recommended temperature for using this product is -20° to +50°.
- Temperature exceeding this range will affect the service life of the product.

3 Description

The EYE III series thermal imaging monocular is for outdoor use. It can be used in the day or night, or in harsh weather (such as rain, snow, fog and haze) without being affected by strong light. It requires no external light source. Even targets hidden behind obstacles (such as branches, grass, and shrubs) can be observed.

The EYE III series thermal imaging monocular is light and easy to carry,

small in size, suitable for single-hand operation, comfortable to use, and rich in functions. It can be widely used for hunting, searching in various outdoor conditions.



7 Charging

The EYE III series is supplied with a built-in rechargeable Li-ion battery pack, which allows operation up to 8 hours. When using the device for the first time, please fully charge it first. The EYE III series features a magnetic charge design.

- Connect the magnetic end of the data cable (10) to the magnetic port (5)
 of the device.
- When in a bumpy environment, you can choose to pull out the magnetic connector and use the standard Type C cable for charging.



- Connect another port of the data cable (10) to the power adapter (11).
- Insert the plug of the adapter to the 110-240V socket (12).
- When the device is charging, the power indicator (6) next to the

magnetic port **(5)** is red. The power indicator **(6)** is on only in the charging status. When the power indicator **(6)** turns green, the device is fully charged.

- When charging, a lighting icon will appear inside the battery icon on the display. The lighting icon will not disappear until the data cable
 (10) is removed or the power is cut off.
- Charging is finished when the interior of the battery icon on the display is completely green
- During using, when the battery icon turns red , this means the power level is low, please charge the device in time to avoid the data loss.

Safety instructions for battery

- The rated voltage of the product is 5V. Please charge the device promptly when the battery is low so that the service life of the thermal imaging monocular will not reduce due to battery over-discharge.
- Don't charge the device instantly while bring the battery from cold environment to warm environment. Charging after 30-40 mins.
- Charge the device at a temperature from 0°C to +50°C, otherwise the battery life will be reduced significantly.

- Never use a damaged or modified charger.
- Don't leave battery unattended when charging. Don't leave the device with a charger connected to the mains longer than over 24 hours after full charge.
- Do not expose the battery to high temperature or to a naked flame.
- Don't connect external device with a current consumption that exceed permitted levels.
- The battery is short circuit protected. However, any situation that may cause short-circuiting should be avoided.
- Don't dismantle the battery from the device.
- The battery capacity may decrease when using the battery in negative temperature, that is normal, not a defect.
- Avoid using the battery at the temperature above the temperature shown in the table, this may decrease the battery's life.
- If the thermal imaging monocular is not used for a long time, recharge the device every 2 months at least and charge to 40%-50% power, then store the device in a dry and ventilated environment.
- Partial charging the battery is necessary if the battery is planned to be idled for long time. Avid fully charged or discharged.
- Keep the battery out of the reach of children.

8 Operation


- Open the lens cap (9) to power on the device, and the startup logo will be displayed on the device screen in 1 second. Also, the EYE III will be powered on with a long press of the Controller (3) for 3s.
- When an infrared image is displayed in the eyepiece, the thermal imaging monocular enters the operating status.
- Rotate the diopter adjustment knob (2) to adjust the resolution of the icon on the display. The diopter adjustment knob is used to adjust the eyepiece diopter for users with different degrees of myopia.
- Shortcut menu: On the home screen, press the Controller (3) to open the shortcut menu, and set the image mode (), scene mode (), screen brightness (), and image sharpness (). Rotate the Controller (3) to switch between different functions on the shortcut menu, and press the Controller (3) to set parameters.
- Main menu: On the home screen, press and hold the Controller (3) to enter the main menu interface for more functions. Rotate the Controller
 (3) to switch between different functions on the main menu, and press the Controller (3) to select the option.
- Photographing / Video recording: On the home screen, briefly press

the **Camera button (4)** to start / stop a video recording. And long press the **Camera button (4)** to take a photo.

- Power off: After using the device, close the lens cap (9), and the power-off shutdown interface will be displayed in 3s. During the shutdown countdown, rotate the Controller (3) or reopen the lens cap (9) to stop
 - it. Alternatively, on the home
 screen, press and hold the
 Controller (3) + Camera button
 (4) at the same time to power off
 the device.
- shutdown countdown, short press the Camera button (4) to active the standby mode.

 Alternatively, on the home screen, short press the Camera button (4) twice to standby the





device. If there is no operation performed for 30 minutes, the product will automatically shut down.

9 Status Bar



The status bar is located at the top of the image interface and displays the information related to the current operating status of the device.

- 1. Current image mode (☀: White hot; ७: Black hot; №: Red hot; ■: Rainbow)
- 2. Current scene mode (: Forest; : Flatland; : Focus; : City)
- 3. Current digital zoom (1.0× to 4.0× adjustable, with an interval of 0.5, such as 1.5×)
- 4. Ultra-clear mode status (displayed when the mode is on)
- 5. Auto calibration (displayed when it is on)
- 6. Compass (displayed when the compass is on)
- 7. Interconnection (displayed when it is connected successfully, it will not be displayed simultaneously with the Wi-Fi icon)
- 8. Microphone (displayed when it is on)
- 9. Wi-Fi status (displayed when it is on, it will not be displayed simultaneously with the Interconnection icon)
- 10. Clock (synchronize the time in the InfiRay Outdoor app)

11. Power status of the built-in battery pack. (When the color in the battery icon is green , it indicates that the battery percentage is higher than 20%, and the power is sufficient. When the color in the icon is red \square , the power is insufficient and need to be charged promptly. When a lightning icon is displayed in the battery icon, the device is powered by an external power supply and the battery pack is in charging)

10 Image Calibration

When the image is degraded or uneven, it can be improved by calibration. Calibration can equalize the background temperature of the detector and eliminate the image defects (such as vertical bars, phantom images, etc.). There are two calibration modes - Auto Calibration and Background Calibration.

- Auto Calibration: Device will calibrate automatically according to the software algorithm. There is no need to close the lens cover (the internal shutter covers the sensor). Turn on/off the auto calibration in the main menu referring to the Section Main Menu - Auto Calibration.
- Background Calibration: Close the lens cap (9) to perform the background calibration automatically.

Photography and Video Recording

EYE III series is equipped with a function for video recording and photography of the observed image which is saved on the built-in 32GB memory storage.

The photo and video files are named with time, so it is suggested to synchronize date and time in the **InfiRay Outdoor** application before using the photo and video functions.

Photography

- On the home screen, press and hold the **Camera button (4)** to take a photo.
- When taking a photo, the photo icon for flashes below the status bar in the upper left corner of the

screen. The photo is taken successfully when the icon disappears.

- Photos are stored in the built-in storage.
- When the exclamation mark icon (!) appears on the right side of the



camera icon, it prompts that the memory space is insufficient. Check and transfer videos and images to other media to free up the space.

Video Recording

- On the home screen, short press the Camera button (4) to start the video recording function.
- Then, the recording timer in the format of the HH: MM: SS (hour: minute: second) will appear on the upper right of the display.
- During recording, it is supported to take a photo with a long press of the Camera button (4). Of course, the other operations to the device are supported during recording.

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- Short press the Camera button (4) again to stop and save the video recording.
- All videos and photos will be saved in the build-in storage.

Note

- You can open and operate the menu during video recording.
- The images taken and the videos recorded are stored in the built-in

- memory space in the format of PIC_HHMMSS.jpg (image) and VIDEO_HHMMSS.mp4 (video), with HHMMSS indicating hour/minute/second.
- The maximum duration of a video recording file is 30 minutes. When the duration is more than 30 minutes, the video will be automatically recorded onto a new file.
- The number of files is limited by the internal memory space of the device. Check the remaining space regularly, and transfer your videos and images to other media to free up the space on the memory card.

Memory Access

When the device is turned on and connected to a computer, it is recognized by the computer as a flash memory card, which is used to access the device's memory and make copies of pictures and videos.

- Connect the device to a computer through the Type C data cable.
- Power on the device for operation. You can view the recorded videos and photos on the computer and charge the built-in battery pack at the same time.
- Double click "my computer" on the computer desktop select the USB flash disk and double click to access the memory space.

• There are different folders named by time in the format of xxxx (year) xx (month) xx (day) in the memory.

You can select required files or folders for copying or deleting operations.

12 Digital Zoom

- EYE III series support to quickly increase the magnification by $1.5 \times / 2 \times / 2.5 \times / 3 \times / 3.5 \times / 4 \times$ as well as to return to the basic magnification 1x.
- On the home screen, clockwise
 - rotate the Controller (3) to digital zoom in, and rotate the Controller (3) anticlockwise to digital zoom out.
- The corresponding magnification is displayed in the status bar.

13 Shortcut Menu Function

On the shortcut menu, you can quickly adjust basic configurations of commonly used functions, including the image mode, scene mode, screen brightness and image sharpness.

- In the home screen, press the **Controller (3)** to enter the shortcut menu.
- Rotate the **Controller (3)** to switch among the options.
 - Image mode (): Select the option and press the Controller (3) to change the image mode. There are four modes - White hot, Black hot, Red hot and Rainbow.
 - Scene mode (): Select the option and press the Controller (3) to change the image mode. There are four modes - Forest, Flatland, Focus and City.



- Screen brightness (-): Select the option and press the Controller (3) to switch the screen brightness from level 1 to 6.
- Image sharpness (\(\)): Select the option and press the **Controller (3)** to switch the image sharpness from level 1 to 4.

- Press and hold the Controller (3) to save the changes and return to the home screen.
- ➤ It will automatically save the changes and return to the home screen if there is no operation within 5s.

14 Main Menu Function

- On the home screen, press and hold the Controller (3) to enter the main menu interface.
- There are two pages of the function options. Rotate the Controller (3)
 to switch among the menu options.
- Menu navigation is cyclical: as soon as the last menu option of the first page is reached, it will turn to the first menu option of the second page when clockwise rotate the Controller (3), and vice versa.
- Press briefly the **Controller (3)** to adjust the current parameters or

enter the sub-menus.

- In all menu interfaces, press and hold the Controller (3) to save and exit to the home screen, or short press the Camera button (4) to return to the home screen without saving.
- Automatic exiting from the menu to the home screen will occur when there is no operation within 10 seconds.
- During the continuous operation of the EYE III, when you exit from the
 main menu, the cursor > remains at the position before exiting. When
 you restart the thermal imaging monocular and enter the main menu
 for the first time, the cursor stays at the first menu option.

Turn Ultra-Clear mode on/off

- Press and hold the Controller (3) to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select the Ultra-Clear option. Ultra-clear option is selected by default when entering the menu.

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- When the function is on, it will automatically search for a WIFI hotspot named ICS and the password is 12345678.
- The method for interconnection refers to the Section 16 Method for Interconnection.
- Only when the interconnection is successful, the icon will appear on the status bar.

Note: The Interconnection function and Wi-Fi function cannot be enabled at the same time, that is, Wi-Fi function will not be enabled when the Interconnection function is on, and vice versa.



PIP



Turn PIP function on/off

- Press and hold the **Controller (3)** to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select the PIP option.
- Press briefly the **Controller (3)** to turn on /off the **PIP** function.
- When the PIP function is on, a small window and a blue box will appear on the screen. The image in the separate window is the 2x magnified image that is captured by the blue box in the main image.



Auto Calibration



Turn auto calibration on/off

- Press and hold the **Controller (3)** to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select the Auto Calibration option.
- Press briefly the Controller (3) to turn on/off the Auto Calibration function.
- When the Auto Calibration function is on, the icon appears on the status bar accordingly.

Turn Microphone on/off • Press and hold the **Controller (3)** to enter the Main Menu interface. Microphone • Rotate the **Controller (3)** to select the **Microphone** option. Press briefly the **Controller (3)** to turn on /off the **Microphone** function. 
• In the submenu, you can choose to turn the **Compass** function on / off, or select Calibration to calibrate the compass.

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- Rotate the Controller (3) for select the option and press the Controller (3) to confirm your selection.
- When the Compass is on, it will be displayed on the middle of the status bar on the top.

Compass Calibration

- When Calibration option is selected, short press the Controller (3) to enter the compass calibration interface. An icon like a triaxial coordinate system appears on the screen.
- In the 15 seconds, rotate the scope along the three axes indicated by the icon, with each axis rotating at least 360°.
- After 15s, the calibration is finished automatically and exit to the Main Menu interface.



Language



Set the GUI Language

- Press and hold the **Controller (3)** to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the **Controller (3)** for select the **Language** option.
- Short press the **Controller (3)** to enter the submenu of the language.
- EYE III series supports five languages, that are English, German, Russian,
 Spanish and Italian.
- Rotate the **Controller (3)** to select the desired language.




Confirm your selection with a short press of the Controller (3) and return to the Main Menu interface automatically.

 Firmware update

- When select Yes, it will automatically search for the update file in the folder named update in the memory space and update it.



Factory Reset

Reset to the factory settings

- Press and hold the **Controller (3)** to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select Factory Reset option.
- Press the Controller (3) to open the submenu of the Factory Reset.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select Yes for restoring factory settings or No for canceling the operation.
- Press the **Controller (3)** to confirm the selection.



• If **Yes** is selected, the scope will restart automatically.

• If **No** is selected, it will be back to the upper menu automatically.

• Press the Camera button (4) briefly to return to the home screen.

15 Wi-Fi Function

The EYE III series can be can connect with the mobile device (laptop or mobile phone) for data transmission via Wi-Fi function.


- On the main menu, turn on the Wi-Fi function (refer to Main Menu Wi-Fi for details).
- After the Wi-Fi function is on, search for the Wi-Fi signal with the name
 "EYEIII_XXXXX-XXXXXXX" on the mobile device, XXXXX-XXXXXX is
 the serial number of your device composed with digits and letters.
- Select the Wi-Fi and enter the password to connect. The initial password is 12345678.
- When Wi-Fi is successfully connected, it supports to control the device via the InfiRay Outdoor App downloaded in the mobile device.

Setting Wi-Fi Name and Password

The name and password of the Wi-Fi in EYE III series can reset on the **InfiRay Outdoor** App.

After the device is connected to the mobile device, locate and click the
 'Settings' icon on the InfiRay Outdoor image screen to enter the
 Settings interface.

- In the text box, enter and submit the new Wi-Fi name (SSID) and password.
- It needs to reboot the device to take the new name and password effect.



Note: If the device is reset to the factory settings, the name and password of the Wi-Fi will also be restored to the default settings.

16 Method for Interconnection

Interconnection with Mobile Device

- Turn on the personal hotspot on the mobile device and modify its name and password to ICS and 12345678.
- Turn the interconnection on in the Main Menu referring to the Main
 Menu Interconnection for details.

- When the interconnection function is on, it will automatically search for the hotspot named ICS and the password is 12345678.
- When the interconnection icon is displayed on the status bar and the prompt
 'Sending Data' appears on the upper left conner of the display, it means that the interconnection between the two device is successful.





 Then, open the InfiRay Outdoor App on the mobile device, you can control the device in the InfiRay Outdoor without affecting the Internet function of the mobile device.


Two EYE III devices could also be interconnected manually.


• First, turn on the Wi-Fi function on one device. And turn on the


- interconnection function on the other device.
- For faster interconnectivity, please modify the Wi-Fi name and password to ICS and 12345678 in the InfiRay Outdoor App before interconnection.
- Simultaneously short press the Camera button (4) + Controller (3) for the two devices to start the pairing.
- When two EYE III are connected, the one whose Wi-Fi is enabled is the

data sender and the other one that the interconnection is on is the data receiver.

The screen image of the date sender will be displayed on the screen of the receiver.









- During image transmission, you can still perform the operation on the EYE III, except photographing and video recording.
- Note that after the Internet function is turned on, the device cannot turn on the Wi-Fi function.

17 Firmware Update

- Notifications about updates will be posted on the official website or social media or InfiRay Outdoor APP.
- Download the update file in the official website
 (www.infirayoutdoor.com) and store it to the folder named "update" in
 the memory space of EYE III.
- Press and hold the Controller (3) to enter the Main Menu interface.
- Rotate the **Controller (3)** to select the **Firmware Update** option.
- Short press the Controller (3) to enter the submenu of the firmware update.
- Rotate the Controller (3) to select "Yes", and press the Controller (3) to confirm the selection.
- The device will automatically search for the update file stored in the folder named "update" in the memory space of EYE III.

Please make sure the device is fully charged before updating.

19 Technical Inspection

It is recommended to carry out a technical inspection each time before using the monocular. Check the following:

- The appearance (there should be no cracks on the body).
- The condition of the object lens and eyepiece (there should be no cracks, greasy spots, dirt or other deposits).
- The battery status (it should be charged).
- The controller/button should be in working order.

Maintenance

The maintenance should be carried out at least twice a year and includes the following steps:

- Wipe the surface of metal and plastic parts to clear off dust and dirt with a cotton cloth. Silicone grease may be used for cleaning process.
- Clean the electric contacts and battery slots on the device using a nongreasy organic solvent.
- Check the glass surface of the eyepiece and lens. If necessary, clear off the dust and sand on the lens (it is perfect to use a non-contact method).

Use a specialized wiping tool and solvent to clean the optical surfaces.
